Spend a summer, semester, or academic year in San Jose, Costa Rica, and take courses to satisfy your Animal Sciences major or minor requirements. The University of Arizona partners with Veritas University to offer you a variety of transferable courses to choose from with the approval of your academic advisor.

You'll pay your UArizona tuition and can use your financial aid and scholarships, including **AZ Excellence** and **Wildcat Excellence** awards in the fall and spring semesters!

Collaborating with your academic advisor is the best way to choose the courses you will take abroad, but to make course selections easier for you, faculty in the School of Animal and Comparative Biomedical Science have pre-approved the following lists of classes. Animal Sciences majors may apply up to **9 credits** and Animal Sciences minors may apply up to **6 credits** from this pre-approved list to satisfy Animal Science program requirements.

Note: If you plan to apply to a professional program such as a DVM program, you must consult with the school's admission team to ensure the courses you choose to take abroad will be accepted by your future program as there may be some restrictions on international credits in your application.
