## **UA London**

Spend a semester or academic year studying abroad in London, England and take courses to satisfy requirements for your History major! The University of Arizona partners with St. Mary's University to offer you a variety of courses to choose from that may be used to satisfy your degree requirements, including general education classes, with the approval of your academic advisor. Awaken your inner artist, humanist, or social scientist by taking regionally specific courses and explore they myriad of courses pre-approved to satisfy History electives within your major.

You'll pay your University of Arizona tuition and get to use your financial aid, including **AZ Excellence** and **Wildcat Excellence awards.** 

It's important to keep in mind that course availability varies each semester and new courses can also be added to the available curriculum, so working with your academic advisor to choose the best courses for your plan of study is always recommended. St. Mary's University uses a unique credit system and courses typically transfer to UArizona at 5 credits each. Double check the UA London program page to confirm the course information for any class you're interested in taking.
