Selection Process: Program proposals are reviewed by a committee consisting of faculty and Global staff.

Proposals are approved for a 2-year period and will be evaluated after the first year. Any concerns raised must be adequately addressed in planning for the second year. The Global office will provide basic support services for programs that are not selected and run as departmentally managed programs.
